Sinfonia No. 8 in G Major/ Sinfonia No. 11 in C Major, Alessandro Scarlatti

Although primarily known as a vocal composer, the output of Alessandro Scarlatti also includes some fine instrumental music. The 12 *Sinfonie di concerto grosso* were composed around 1715. The two on tonight's program consist of five short movements immediately following each other and are scored for flute (recorder), strings and continuo.
